

What has changed in the Argentine Merchant Marine since the 30th AGA?

IFSMA Res. 4/2004 – Declaration of Buenos Aires (May,2004)

"The 30th Annual General Assembly expressed its full support for the Argentine Government repeal of Decree No. 1772/91 which will establish the basis for rebuilding the Argentine Merchant Marine."



In August 2004, the President of Argentina, derogated the Decree No. 1772/91 through the Decree No. 1010/04 and *"tried to establish the basis for rebuilding our Merchant Marine"*. Still in force, it has produced good results but has not been enough to reach the goal.







For more than 10 years we have worked with different government officials, and have advised Deputies and Senators to achieve a suitable text for a Merchant Marine Law. At this moment, we are pushing a project that was approved by the Chamber of Senators wich is expected to be sancioned in law by the Chamber of Deputies in the next months.



Other issues on which CCUOMM has worked to establish standards on board ships.

Complete amendment of the National Regulation which establishes the standards of training, certification and watchkeeping for Argentinean seafarers, adapting it to the STCW Manila.



Other issues on which CCUOMM has worked to establish standards on board ships.

Collective Bargaining Agreement according to the current requirements regarding professional tasks, the implementation of the ILO MLC 2006 on ships, and even human relationships on board and equal treatment for women. It should be mentioned that the chapter that establishes the Rights and Guarantees for Women on board is one of the most advanced internationally.




* CCUOMM has its own recreational field located just 45 minutes away from Buenos Aires downtown.





So, we can provide free accommodation for IFSMA members


