






Statistics of Indian shipping



- India is blessed with long coastline of 7500 km, only country which has an ocean named after it
- 12 major ports and 200 non major port authorities delivering
 1000m tonnes of trade
- 11m grt in 1000 ships of all kinds including domestic shipping but negligible inland water system comprising over 14000 km spread over 111 nationally declared waterways
- Training close to 10000 officers, engineers, and Ratings per year in 140 approved institutes and striving for double digit contribution in crewing global industry
- Supported by officers and seamen union and RPSL manning agents,
 10 IACS Classification societies including Indian Register, Institute of
 Marine Engineers, Naval Architects and Marine Technologists




Objectives of CMMI
